

## Web Interface Designer

Innovative company seeks a Web Interface Designer who will work with a development team to design a web portal that displays real-time energy usage information to customers. The web site will retrieve live energy data from a back-end database and display that information through various visualizations. Customers will also have remote control over their appliances via the web based user interface. Web site needs to be visually effective and engaging, lightweight, and portable, preferably written in AJAX.

### Responsibilities:

- Design web sites and ensure that they are visually effective and easy to access
- Advise management on the categories and information needed to construct the site
- Design draft pages for approval or modification
- Utilize existing graphing APIs such as Google Chart API to rapid prototype visualizations
- Test the web sites for functionality in different browsers and at different resolutions
- Update current information on web pages
- Direct the layout, visual appearance, and usability of the website.
- Must set clear expectations and maintain project timelines

### Preferred Candidate Qualifications:

- Candidate must have 4-5 years working experience in Web development
- Expert level knowledge of hand-coding HTML, CSS, and AJAX
- Familiarity with LAMP
- Familiarity with the Google Chart API
- Experiences in Flash and Actionscript
- Experiences in database design is a plus
- Proficient time management and scheduling history
- Must have examples of web / landing page design projects; clean, corporate, user friendly sites.
- Must have at least 3-5 sample layouts of site design for consideration.
- Additional experience with e-mail marketing campaign design or online advertising a plus.
